REGULATION & RULES

8. Plants

8.1 Plants In The Common Area

- 8.1.1 Residents are not allowed to do any activity that may cause damage or ruin the garden, grass, bushes, and trees.
- 8.1.2 Residents are not allowed to use Common Area for their own private use.
- 8.1.3 Damaging the Common Area particularly landscape, plants, grass area and track is strictly prohibited.

Any repair / replacement for the damages will be charged to the Resident concerned.

- 8.1.4 Private plants are not allowed to be planted in the Common Area particularly in the garden.
- 8.1.5 Residents are not allowed to store / place any pot of plants of any kind in the Common Area.

8.2 Plants On The Balconies

- 8.2.1 Residents are not allowed to place excessive plants / pots of plants at their own balconies.
- 8.2.2 Residents are not allowed to plant any illegal plants.
- 8.2.3 Residents must always clean their balconies from dead leaves and dispose of them accordingly.
- 8.2.4 When watering the plants on the balcony, Residents must always take care that excess water does not go to the Units below.

New Normal Phase: 1



Dear Residents and Unit Owners,

Warmest Greetings from The Pakubuwono House!

As we all move toward "New Normal", starting on July 1, 2020, Building Management will start allowing showing unit and fit out work with some restrictions applied.

Showing Unit Restrictions are:

- 1. Maximum 3 (three) people including the sales agent(s) in each showing.
- 2. Must inform management 2 (two) days in advance.
- 3. Showing by appointments are limited to 3 (three) slot per day.
- 4. Only 1 (one) visit per day for each sales agent.

Fit Out Restrictions are:

- 1. Only 4 (four) workers and 1 (one) coordinator can be allowed inside the unit at one time.
- All registered workers have to pass chargeable Rapid Test that will be executed by management's
 medical personnel. If the result is reactive, the related person prohibited to enter the area.
- 3. Hand sanitizer should always be made available during the fit-out time.
- 4. Disinfectant spray has to be performed every day before leaving the premise.

At this early phase only these two activities will be allowed, other conditions remaining unchanged as announced earlier. Building Management will continue coordinate with the Board of Tenancy Association (PPRS) to loosen up others procedures gradually with some restrictions still applied.



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TIPS & TRICK

"Making Chopped Salad"

Making homemade salad dressing is the key to a great chopped salad. Here are a few tips to make a creamy emulsion where the oil and vinegar incorporate perfectly:

Whisk by hand with a large whisk

Use a medium-sized bowl to allow for enough movement of the whisk

Add the olive oil little by little. Add it tablespoon by tablespoon and whisk in between until the oil fully incorporates

Ingredients:

1 recipe homemade Italian Dressing

1 Romaine heart (3 cups)

5 cups leafy lettuce

1 large shallot

1 English cucumber (2 cups chopped)

½ cup cherry tomatoes

½ cup ripe green olives, halved

½ cup jarred sliced pepperoncini

¼ cup Parmesan shavings or shred, plus more to serve

¼ teaspoon red pepper flakes, optional

Method:

Make the homemade Italian Dressing

Chop romaine and lettuce. Thinly slice the shallot. Peel and chop cucumber. Slice tomatoes and olives in half

Mix together all the ingredients for the salad, including the dressing and toss to combine. If making in advance, refrigerate the components separately; bring the dressing to room temperature before serving

Turn chopped salad into a main dish

This chopped salad is so tasty. You'll want to make it for everymeal. To mix it up a bit, you could turn it into a main dish salad by:

Add protein like hard boiled eggs, seared ahi tuna, or chopped chicken

Serve with a side like cornbread or artisan bread




DID YOU KNOW?

International Chess Day

The International Chess Day is celebrated annually on July 20, the day the International Chess Federation (FIDE) was founded, in 1924. The idea to celebrate this day as the international chess day was proposed by UNESCO, and it has been celebrated as such since 1966, after it was established by FIDE. FIDE, which has 181 chess federations as its members, organizes chess events and competitions around the world on this day.

As recently as 2013, the International Chess Day was celebrated in 178 countries, according to FIDE President Kirsan Ilyumzhinov. On December 12, 2019, the UN General Assembly unanimously approved a resolution recognizing the day.

The day is celebrated by many of the 605 million regular chess players around the world. A 2012 Yougov poll showed that "a surprisingly stable 70% of the adult population has played chess at some point during their lives". This number holds a t approximately the same level in countries as diverse as the US, UK, Germany, Russia, and India.




National Children's Day
